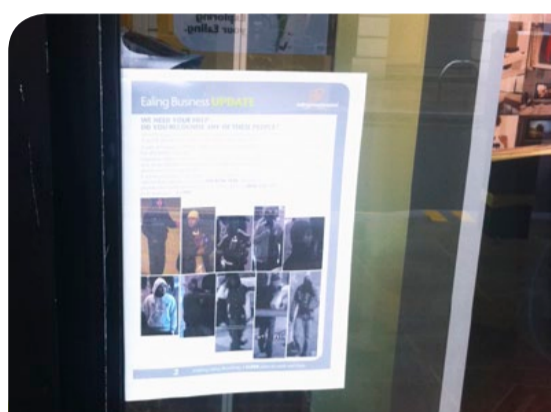

High Street Fund

A new **High Street Fund** for businesses was launched on 24th August by the **Mayor of London** and **Sir William Castell**.

The fund is aimed at micro businesses (as a guide, up to 10 employees) across the UK. The businesses will be from those areas directly affected by the public order disturbances during August 2011 and must have reported a crime to the police in order to claim.

Application forms will be available to download from today (Friday, August 26), and available in branches of Barclays and Santander. All completed application forms will need to be lodged at one of these two Banks.
